Note:

1. **Compulsory Attendance:** Appearing in Term 1 Theory Examination is compulsory. No re-examination will be conducted for absentees.
2. **Admit Card Requirement:** Admit card is mandatory for appearing in the examination. A duplicate admit card may be issued on written request, which will cost ₹100.
3. **Exam Duration:** The theory examination will be of 3 hours duration.
4. **Reporting & Exam Timing:** Students must report to the school by 7:20 AM. The examination will commence at 8:00 AM

and conclude at 11:00 AM.

5. **Lunch & Dispersal:** On all examination days, the lunch break will be from 11:00 AM to 11:30 AM and students will be dispersed at 11:30 AM.
6. **Seating:** Students must remain seated for the entire duration of the examination. No student will be allowed to leave early.
7. **Uniform:** Students must be in proper, neat and clean regular school uniform.
8. **Stationery:** Students must bring their own pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, and other required stationery. Borrowing items during the examination is not allowed.
9. **Preparatory Leave:** Thursday, 17 September 2026, will be observed as a Preparatory Leave for all students.
10. **Classes Pre-Nursery to V Schedule:** For classes Pre-Nursery to V, regular classes resume from Tuesday, 22 September 2026. Dispersal on 22 September 2026 and 23 September 2026 will be at 11:30 AM.
11. **Classes VI to X Schedule:** For classes VI to X, regular classes will resume from Thursday, 24 September 2026.
