Note:

- 1. Compulsory Attendance:** Appearing in Term 1 Theory Examination is compulsory. No re-examination will be conducted for absentees.
- 2. Admit Card Requirement:** Admit card is mandatory for appearing in the examination. A duplicate admit card may be issued on written request, which will cost ₹100.
- 3. Exam Duration:** The theory examination will be of 3 hours duration.
- 4. Reporting & Exam Timing:** Students must report to the school by 7:20 AM. The examination will commence at 8:00 AM and conclude at 11:00 AM.
- 5. Lunch & Dispersal:** On all examination days, the lunch break will be from 11:00 AM to 11:30 AM and students will be dispersed at 11:30 AM.
- 6. Seating:** Students must remain seated for the entire duration of the examination. No student will be allowed to leave early.
- 7. Uniform:** Students must be in proper, neat and clean regular school uniform.
- 8. Stationery:** Students must bring their own pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, and other required stationery. Borrowing items during the examination is not allowed.
- 9. Preparatory Leave:** Thursday, 17 September 2026, will be observed as a Preparatory Leave for all students.
